Deadlines for Applying to the Roycroft Campus Fall show is **September 1st, 2019**

Questions you should consider:

Should I just create what I want or what I think the audience might be interested in?

Do I have enough artwork to fill my table/space?

How should I price my work?

How do I display my artwork so that it is visible and appealing to viewers?

What can I do with my table space to make it attractive and appealing to the audience?

Do I have additional money so I can make change?

Do I have additional supplies with me (tape, scissors, pencil/pen, paper, etc.) in case I need to make repairs, attach displays, or additional work?

Do I have a sign or contact information (but not too much) so people know who I am or how to reach me if they have additional questions about my work?
